Sermon Summary for 4th February, 2018

"WHERE IS YOUR FAITH?"

Mark 4: 35 - 41

(Mr. Kofi Osew)

Three things are noteworthy from the passage...

In this life, storms are normal, even when we are with Jesus: some believe that when you are doing God's will, or when the Lord is with you, there will be no storms. Mark 4:35-36, however, shows us that it was Jesus who told the disciples "Let us cross over to the other side", and He went with them; yet, a fierce wind-storm arose, and the waves were breaking into the boat, so that it was already filling. The storms of life are therefore a normal aspect of life in a broken world.

When great, difficult and fierce storms arise, different people react differently: Some will pray, others won't or can't pray; some begin to panic and are overcome with fear; some post it on Facebook or change their status on WhatsApp; some immediately conclude that God has forsaken them; and some stay calm, trusting in God and fighting to the end. From the passage, Jesus was at the back of the boat, asleep, with his head on a pillow. The disciples on the other hand were awake. Matthew 8:25 tells us that, His disciples came to *Him* and woke Him up, saying, "Lord, save us! We are perishing!" Mark 4:38 says: they woke Him up and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" Jesus then arose and rebuked the wind and there was a great calm (Mark 4:39). Even from sleep, Jesus was full of faith while the disciples were so full of fear.

Jesus expects faith even when the storm is very fierce: The storm that arose in Mark 4:35-41 must have been very fierce to ignite the response it did from the disciples (at least seven of whom should be fishermen – judging from John 21:1-3). But, immediately after Jesus stilled the storm, He asked the disciples: "Why are you so fearful? How *is it* that you still have no faith?" (Mark 4:40). Luke 8:25a says "Where is your faith?" Jesus, here, clearly expected faith even when the storm was extremely fierce. It also shows that even though the disciples were calling on Jesus for salvation, it was out of fear of imminent drowning and not out of faith in Him and in the power of His Word. They didn't even know the manner of person they were dealing with (Mark 4:41). Even amid the storm, Jesus expects prayer and cries offered to God to be backed by faith. Without faith, it is impossible to please Him (Hebrews 11:6). James 1:5-7 says if your prayer is not in faith, and free from all doubt, you should not expect that you will receive anything from the Lord. Will He find your faith abounding even in the midst of the fierce storms of this life?
