Sermon Summary for 4th March, 2018

"DEAL DRASTICALLY WITH TEMPTATIONS"

Genesis 39: 1 - 12; Mark 9: 42 - 50

(Mr. Kofi Duodu Asomaning)

Jesus continues his teaching in Mark 9 about the impact of interpersonal relationships that affect the Kingdom of God. He warns his disciples against the deadly consequences of sin. The passage can be broken into 3 parts

1. Causing others to stumble vs 42

Jesus here suggests it is better to die by being drowned in the sea than causing even the "least" in the Kingdom of God to stumble.

2. Causing yourself to stumble vs 43 - 48

Jesus points to 3 body parts that may cause one to sin – the hand, the foot and the eye. All these body parts exist in twos but yet Jesus speaks about removing only one of them. This makes it obvious that he is not speaking literally. In the Old Testament physical deformity disqualified one from becoming a priest - so Jesus implies that it is better to be outwardly disqualified and to be saved by a cleansed heart than to be outwardly qualified and not enter life. This is a warning to rid our lives of things that would contaminate us and lead us into sin.

3. Being Salt for Christ vs 49 & 50

3 uses of salt highlighted;

i) Salt was used as a reminder of God's covenant and his faithfulness Lev2: 13

ii) Salt changes the taste of the environment– Matt 5:13

iii) Salt acts as a preservative and sets against moral decay

Jesus is calling his disciples to be SALTED for Christ by remembering God's covenant to them, being willing to be different and confronting the status quo to set upright moral standards.

A closer look at the text shows that, when reversed, these 3 steps emphasize the fact that a life without Christ leads to death. A disciple (salt) who starts to lose his "saltiness" must cut off those habits that lead to sin otherwise soon they will be causing not only themselves but others to sin leading to death.

Joseph knew this. He remembered God's covenant with him and cut off the temptation of a pretty woman. On hindsight, he would have exchanged being used by God as a vessel for the redemption of the whole Israel for such fleeting pleasure.

Remember that although temptations usually look inconsequential, they have lasting implications not only for you but potentially for generations after you.

1. Accept Jesus as your Lord and personal savior to save you from the power of sin.

2. Acknowledge that God can help you in your moment of temptation.

3. Ask the Lord to provide an escape for you when tempted.

4. Take measures to separate yourself from those habits and relationships that lead you to sin.

- Continue to pray for every Church member; that the Lord will preserve every soul from untimely death; rebuke the spirit of death hovering over LIC and every family in the Church (Ps 118:17; Ps 13:3)
- Pray for the Lord's continued comfort and restoration for families that are grieving; for the peace of God to guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. Pray against the spirit of fear, that we will find rest in God's love and protection (Phil 4.6-7; Isa 26:3; Isa 41:10; Ps 30:5)
- Travail in prayer and ask that Christ will be formed in the hearts of every LIC member (Galatians 4:19)
