# Sermon Summary for 11th March, 2018

#### "JESUS CHRIST IS EVERYTHING"

#### Colossians 2: 2 - 12

(Rev. Steve Levy)

Jesus wants the church to know the mystery of God. Which is found in Christ. In him and only in him are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. No one must deceive us into thinking we need more than Christ.

How do we get to know this?

Firstly, we must be confident that it is possible to have this knowledge.

We are confident because it is God himself who has qualified us to share in: the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light (Col. 1: 12, 13). How? We have been rescued and brought to the kingdom of the Son he loves by redemption, the forgiveness of sins. Israel was redeemed in the same way. When the Lord looks at our sin, he sees the lamb who bore the sins of the world. So, all our sins are forgiven. Jesus took them all on the cross.

In the Exodus, how were the Israelites to know that the judgement had passed? By the fact that the firstborn would still be alive and because he lived. they knew they could travel to the Promised Land. Our Firstborn who lives is the image of the invisible God. He created all things and is holding all things: together and has been given authority over all things. He is our Firstborn from: the dead and because he is ours we should be encouraged in heart.

Secondly, we must be united in love.

Jesus' body is the church. If we are to know the full riches of complete understanding, the mystery of God, we have to be united to others in the church in love. This is what the apostles of Jesus suffered for, following the example of Jesus (Col 1:24). In Col 3:11-15, he tells us exactly how to do this. We have to love, forgive, care, accept one another, or we will never get the wisdom and : knowledge we need.

But all wisdom and knowledge are found in Christ.

The Bible has many titles for Jesus. Why does he call him Christ here? Earlier in the letter he is called the Son, the Lord and other names but here he is called the Christ. The Christ refers to his anointing. Our anointing comes from the anointed one. To know the Spirit of wisdom and of knowledge and of life we have to look to the Christ. There is no other anointing outside of him. He: gives the Spirit without measure (see John 3:34).

Spurgeon said it better than I ever could: "The Holy Spirit turns our eyes entirely away from self; he tells us that we are nothing, but that 'Christ is all in all' Remember, therefore, it is not thy hold of Christ that saves thee--it is Christ; it : Mar 23: Mr. Emmanuel Mantey is not thy joy in Christ that saves thee--it is Christ; it is not even faith in Christ, though that be the instrument--it is Christ's blood and merits; therefore, look not so much to thy hand with which thou art grasping Christ, as to Christ; look not to thy hope, but to Jesus, the source of thy hope; look not to thy faith, but to Jesus, the author and finisher of thy faith. We shall never find happiness by looking at our prayers, our doings, or our feelings; it is what Jesus is, not what we are, that gives rest to the soul. If we would at once overcome Satan and have peace with God, it must be by 'looking unto Jesus'. Keep thine eye simply on him; let his death, his sufferings, his merits, his glories, his intercession, be fresh upon thy mind; when thou wake in the morning look to him; when thou lie down at night look to him. Oh! let not thy hopes or fears come between thee and Jesus: follow hard after him, and he will never fail thee.
