Monday Review your Christian life	Read Psalm 139:1-14. Worship God in songs and prayer. Consider His faithfulness and power.	How is your personal bible study? How is your personal prayer time? How often have you shared the Word of God with your family and friends? Do you consciously rely on the Holy spirit for direction? 2 Timothy 2.15	Confess your weaknesses to the Lord. Ask the Holy Spirit for strength and consistency. Ask for grace to mature in Christ. Ask the Holy Spirit to impart you with spiritual gifts. 1 Corinthians 12:1-11 & 2 Timothy 1:7-9.
Tuesday Review your service to God	Review your devotion to God's work. What is your personal contribution to the things of God? Confess your shortcomings to the Lord. Hebrews 4:14-16	How committed are you to God's work? Are your personal commitments over riding your commitment to the things of God? Are u consistent in your service to God?	Ask the Holy Spirit to direct you to the right ministry where you can function effectively. Ask for grace to be committed to your call. Ask God for zeal and a passion for service. John 2:17, Colossians 3:2
Wednesday (Jesus Died to set you free from sin)	Read and meditate on the following scriptures (Ephesians 1:7; Romans 6:1-14, 18). As you meditate on the scriptures, give thanks to God for His finished work through Christ. Confess your sins to Him and ask for His mercy and forgiveness (1 John 1:9)	Because you are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, and based on Christ's finished work, pray and lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares you (Hebrews 12:1). Pray for a Christlike focus in life. Pray that you will be able to fix your gaze on him (Hebrews 12:2). Pray that you will never become tired or weary or discouraged fighting against sin (Hebrews 12:3-4).	Pray for a fresh in-filling of the Holy Spirit, ask for fresh fire and a spiritual awakening (Ephesians 5:18). Pray for a constant leadership and guidance of the Holy Spirit. Ask Him to deliver you from snares and traps of the devil and from all temptation (Galatians 5:16; 1 Corinthians 10:13; Romans 8:14). Ask for grace to walk in complete victory over sin and temptations (Romans 6:14; Hebrews 4:16).

Raise an altar of Love care and righteousness in this nation. Pray against galamsey that God will intervene. Pray for the security of the nation against armed robberies and ritual murders. Psalms 125:3	Ask the Lord to Cover the nation with His mercy and pardon. Pray that wherever there is iniquity, the Lord will have mercy for the sake of the saints. Pray that any abominable act perpetrated in the name of this country, May the Lord intervene and Restore his promises on this Land Zechariah 1:1-6
Sunday Jesus prayed and still prays for you.	Read and meditate on the following scriptures (Mark 1:35; Luke 5:15-16; Luke 11:1-8; Hebrews 7:24-25). Confess your prayerlessness and ask for God's mercy and forgiveness (1 Samuel 12:23; 1 John 1:9).	Pray and come against every demonic hold over your prayer life. Pray that the bondage of prayerlessness in your life will be completely broken in the name of Jesus (1 John 5:14-15; Matthew 7:7; Mark 11:22-24). Ask for a revival in your prayer life, that the Lord will send fresh fire into your prayer life. Pray for the grace for persistent prayer (Luke 18:1). Pray and ask the Lord to teach you How to pray (Luke 11:1-2).	Pray that the character and nature of the Lord Jesus Christ will be formed in your heart (Galatians 4:19, Philippians 1:21). Pray for hands that never grow weary in prayer (Exodus 17:10-12). Pray against unbelief and doubts that contend with your faith in your walk with the Lord and during your times of prayer. Ask for an unshaken faith (James 1:5-8; Mark 11:24).
