Sermon Summary for 8h April, 2018

"JESUS WELCOMES LITTLE CHILDREN"

Psalm 127: 3 - 5; Mark 10: 13 - 16

(Dr. Mrs. Araba Sefa-Dedeh)

Jesus has many children of different biological ages. There are the very little ones, the teenagers, the adults and the elderly ones and He loves and welcomes them all. He is our Parent; our Father and Mother: (Gal 4:6, Isaiah 66:13, Isaiah 49:15, Heb. 12:7).

However, you cannot be welcomed unless you come. Mark 10:13-16: indicates that Jesus was very upset with the disciples for stopping the: children from coming to Him.

He is still now very upset over all the reasons that stop us from coming: to be welcomed to an intimate loving, relationship with Him.

Some Reasons:

- Wrong notions of what love is no discipline
- Guilt /Low self-esteem ourselves or others telling us we are not good enough to be loved by God
- Anger at God for the evil and pain in the world
- Rebellion unwillingness to obey God's commands
- Circumstances in life including intellectual problems causing us to doubt God's very existence.

Some have come but there is no intimacy, no fellowship of talking to: Jesus daily about joys and sorrows and resting in his love.

The good news is that like the story of the Prodigal Son (Luke15:11 32). Jesus wants us to come so he can welcome us and throw a party : Apr 17: Master Fiff Nkunim Ampomah of blessings for us.

Loving others, especially children, because Jesus loves us.

It is only when we know how much Jesus loves us that we can truly love all others, those biologically ours and those God sends our way.

We need to treat the little ones, even the challenging ones, the way : Apr 18: Mr. Dzidzienyo Makafui Senanu Jesus treats us, with love, tolerance, patience, gentleness and self : Apr 18: Master Henry Kpakpo Allotey control (Gal.5:22-33).

Let us work at building an atmosphere of love that affirms and praises; Apr 19: Mr. Samuel Quarm so that firm discipline can be accepted in our homes.

Let us also remember that as we read from Psalm 127:3-5, children both spiritual and biological are a heritage from God and we are Apr 20: Mr. Crossby Osei Tutu blessed when we have a quiver full of them.
