Sermon Summary for 6th May, 2018

"JESUS RE-STATES HIS MISSION"

Isaiah 52: 13 - 15; 53: 7 - 12; Mark 10: 41 - 45

(Rev. Austin Okomohwo)

The Lord's mission on earth was more than to preach, heal and teach. At the heart of his mission was the souls of men, the value he put on their souls and the price he was willing to pay for their freedom.

As the Lord shared with his disciples the end that was imminent in Jerusalem. they began to think of their personal preservation, positioning and privileges in the coming kingdom. These elements inform and rule human perspective and practice of leadership in every generation and is even very much manifest in the communities of believers now. Jesus' clear instruction is "It shall not be so amongst you"

What must prevail as a mind-set and practice in leadership for the believer is that the desire for greatness should be a desire to serve. The path to greatness is service. To be great is to serve. To be the greatest is to serve the most.

The mission of Jesus exemplifies this paradigm of leadership. In his choice to serve "he came to give his life as a ransom for many..." that he may lead them into a new future. The value of each soul to him is revealed in the price he was willing to pay. His choice was the cross and the grave. His choice expresses his love. His choice showed his mission.

As partners with him in this great mission we too must operate from a choice to serve and a practice to so do. In our service we must give of ourselves and give up our self to ransom as many as the Lord brings our way. We must consciously and conscientiously seek to bring others out of darkness into His light. He has paid the ultimate price for our freedom. We must now pay the price to make this freedom known to all men. We must, as partners, share the value he placed on souls and we must pay significant prices to see them free If for nothing else we must do it because we have experienced this value of Jesus in our salvation. Your extended family, close friends and neighbors wait. Let's go to them with the Lord's ransom!!!
