Sermon Summary for 15th July, 2018

"JESUS' AUTHORITY CHALLENGED"

Exodus 5: 1 - 9; Mark 11: 27 - 33

(Mr. Dan Agamah)

Less than a week before He went to the cross. Jesus demonstrated His authority in three unmistakable ways: To prepare for His entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. He instructed His disciples to commandeer a donkey (vv.1-8); then He pronounced a curse upon an unproductive fig tree (vv. 12-14); and before He was through. He cast the moneychangers out of the Temple, calling Herod's magnificent structure. "My house" (vv. 15-19).

All of this was very offensive to the religious establishment, of course, because it undermined their own self-imposed authority and forced them to confront the truth of who He is. So, they sought to discredit him by posing questions that challenged the authority by: which he acted.

Because of this. Jesus sought to expose their willful rejection of the truth. This He did by also posing a guestion to His opponents, "Was the baptism of John from heaven, or from men? (Mark 11:30). The scribes and Pharisees were unable to answer because they had rejected the preparatory announcement of John the Baptist and placed themselves above the authority of the Word of God.

That, unfortunately, is precisely what men and women do today. The reason that many reject Jesus as their Messiah and Saviour is that they place themselves above the authority of the Word of God. They trust in their own reasoning rather than in divine revelation.

Pharaoh asked the same kind of guestion the Sanhedrin did: Who is the Lord, that I should obey his voice? Like Pharaoh, very often, we do not obey the voice of God and we challenge his authority because we have a low esteem of who He truly is.

Many of us today say we love and believe in God while at the same time we inwardly both reject Jesus and reject the clear, revealed commandments of the Father in the Bible. If this is us, then Jesus is letting us know that our boast of loving the Father is impossible.

Jesus is Lord, and He does have authority in our lives and ministries. Our resources, our private property, our stuff - A true recognition of his authority will cause us to hold our every plan in subjection to God's Will and make us recognize that Jesus, the divine potter, has absolute power over the clay and moulds it according to his imperial pleasure.
