# Sermon Summary for 29th July, 2018 "OUR DUTY TO GOD AND COUNTRY"

Jer. 38: 14-23; Mark 12: 13-17

(Prof. E. Kweku Osam)

In His final journey towards the cross. Jesus encounters a series of opposition from the Jewish leaders. In Mark 12:13-17, we find the Pharisees and Herodians—two groups that were ideologically incompatible teaming up to trap Jesus. They sent spies to Jesus (Luke 20:20); and through a strategy of flattery and pretense, the spies expected to trip him up. Their guestion to Jesus, on the surface of it, looked simple and straightforward: "Is it right to pay the imperial tax to Caesar or not? Should we pay or shouldn't we?" (Mark 12: 14-15) They were expecting YES or NO from Him. Jesus saw through their duplicity and amazed them in responding: "Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." (Mark 12:17)

The Bible makes it clear that "there is no authority except that which God has established." (Romans 13:1). So we are obliged to discharge our duty to the state, no matter how bad the government might be. The duty includes paying taxes (Romans 13:6); obeying the laws and submitting to authority (1 Peter 2:13-16); showing respect and honour (Romans 13:7; and praying for those in authority (1 Timothy 2:1-4).

But here is a caveat: when the state makes laws that are directly opposed to the Word of God, we are duty bound to disobey those laws; But Peter and the apostles answered, "We must obey God rather than men." (Acts 5:29) Let's remember, however, that when we engage in such civil disobedience, there would be repercussions and we should be prepared to pay that price.

Our primary duty to God is captured in a statement Jesus makes in Matthew 22:34-38: "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment." We have to love God with our everything, including what we give to the state. Let's note that love requires obedience. Jesus made this point very clearly: "If you love me, keep my commands." (John: 14:15; see also John 14:21, 23&24 and Ecclesiastes 12:13&14).

The enemies of Jesus thought they had trapped Him; but their question gave Jesus the opportunity to make a declaration on our duty as citizens of a country and our even greater duty to God.
