## Sermon Summary for 16 th September, 2018 "SIGNS OF THE END - I"

Daniel 12: 1-3; Mark 13: 1-23 (Rev. Julius D. Coomson)
It is often said that everything with a beginning has an end. In Mark 13, Jesus teaches us that, the Jewish temple and our world will one day come to an end. The end of the world will take place when Jesus returns. How are we to respond to the information Jesus gives us about the end?
Our knowledge of Eschatology (the study about the end time) should not lead us into unhealthy arguments, but rather, help us prepare our hearts to meet the Lord Jesus.
Jesus had declared the temple barren when he cursed the fig tree (Mark 11:15-19) but his disciples were still impressed with the outward appearance of the temple (v1). Jesus again reminds them of the fate of the temple (v2) which led them to ask in v3\&4 (and Matt. 24:3): 1. when the temple will be destroyed, 2 . what signs will indicate its destruction and 3 . what the sign of Jesus' return and of the close of the age will be. Jesus' answer is from vv537. In summary, Jesus indicates that the period before He returns will be characterized by intense period of distress (tribulation). Daniel also prophesied about this in Daniel 12:1-3.
Verses 5-13 and verses 15-23 show the first and second parts of the tribulation respectively. Four things characterize vv5-13:

1) Deceit (v6): by false messiahs. If Jesus warned his core disciples to be careful about this ( v 5 ) then we also need to be very careful. We shouldn't forget that if the authority of the true Messiah is rejected, false messiahs can : and will become substitutes. Is Jesus Christ the Lord of your life?
: 2) Warfare (v7-8a)
:3) Natural disasters (v8a). Jesus taught that these do not indicate that the end has arrived but show the beginning of the tribulation (v8b).
2) Persecution.: This can be categorized into official (v9-11) and relational (v12-13) types. Jesus encourages us that persecution should propel the proclamation of the gospel (v10) and not kill its fire. We shouldn't forget that we are not alone. The Holy Spirit is with us (v11).
:The abomination that leads to desolation (v14) will usher in the second part of the tribulation, often called the Great Tribulation due to the intense distress which will characterize the period (v19). The abomination that causes desolation is mentioned three times in Daniel 9:24-27; 11:31; 12:11 and in 2 Thess 2:3-10. We learn that it concerns a ruler who will enter into a contract to : protect Israel but will frustrate it midway and set himself up in God's place demanding worship. He will ultimately be destroyed by the Lord Jesus (2Thess 2:8). Jesus warns the Jews to flee from Judea when this happens.
Jesus cautions us to be on guard so that these things do not take us by surprise (v23). Are we being diligent or will they take us by surprise?
