Sermon Summary for 23rd September, 2018

"SIGNS OF THE END - II"

Isaiah 13: 6-13; Mark 13: 24-37 (Rev. Julius D. Coomson)

The Lord Jesus' Second Coming will usher in the close of the age. It is therefore important for us to know how Jesus' coming will be like. From our text, we observe that Jesus will come:

- 1. Gloriously (v24-26): Following the Great Tribulation (vv14-22), the sun will be darkened, the moon will not give its light, the stars will fall from the sky and the heavenly bodies will be shaken as Isaiah prophesied in Isaiah 13:10. This total darkness will serve as a backdrop for the Lord Jesus to return with great power and glory. The darkness will ensure that no one will miss His majestic glory. At His incarnation, Jesus came silently as a servant to suffer for evil but at His Second Coming, He will come as a King to destroy evil. Are you ready?
- 2. Redemptively (v27): The return of the Lord will result in salvation for His people. Jesus will gather his elect from every place. Not one of them will be lost. This should be encouraging to those of us who have put our trust in the Lord Jesus Christ. According to Titus, Jesus' Second Coming is a blessed hope to Christian believers (Tit. 2:13). We are to be excited, as we look forward to the return of the Lord, just as a bride looks forward to the arrival of the bridegroom.
- 3. Certainly (v28-31): The Lord Jesus made sure His disciples will not miss the certainty of His return. Just as people in His days could predict the certainty of summer from the changes seen in the fig tree, so all the signs Jesus spoke about should assure us that the end is near. Jesus makes it even more certain by stating that "this generation" (referring to mankind of all time) as used in Mark 8:38, will not pass until all the signs of the end have been fulfilled. His words will not fail. Heaven and earth will pass away but His words shall surely be fulfilled.
- 4. ...and Suddenly (v32): Even though the Lord gave general signs of the end time, no one knows the day or hour of Jesus' coming; not the angels or even Jesus himself (since He voluntarily limited the use of His divine privileges when He took on flesh Phil. 2:5-9). Therefore, we are to be alert and seriously watching out for the Lord's return. We are to be busy with the task the Lord has assigned us. This includes reaching out to the lost and discipling the saved. In what ways are you committed to the Great Commission? Preparing for Jesus' return also means that we are to be pursuing a lifestyle of holiness. The apostles emphasized holy living when they talked about Jesus' Second Coming in their writings (Romans 13:11-14, 1 John 3:2-3, Titus 2:11-14). Are there changes you will make to your life if you knew the exact time the Lord Jesus will come? Now is the time to effect those changes because "now is our salvation nearer than we first believed" (Romans 13:11b). Jesus is coming. Are you ready?
