Sermon Summary for 3rd February, 2019

"SALVATION IS IMPOSSIBLE WITHOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT"

Ezekiel 36: 25 - 27; John 3: 1 - 8

Mr. Theo Aryee:

- 1. Salvation is impossible without the born-again experience. 'Unless, one is born again, he cannot see the Kingdom of God. (Jn. 3: 3). The term born again is synonymous with 'rebirth' and 'regeneration', and both are used in this write-up.
- 2. It is the Holy Spirit who makes one born again unto salvation. 'I tell: you the truth, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the Kingdom of God (Jn. 3:5). The rebirth must be 'of' the Spirit. As a baby does not contribute to its birth, so the Christian contributes nothing to his: or her rebirth. No one knows into complete detail when and how the Holy Spirit accomplishes the regeneration. However, the scriptures are clear: that He does it. (See Titus 3: 5, 6: 1 Cor 12:3)
- 3. The Holy Spirit convicts sinners unto salvation. Jesus told his disciples that the Holy Spirit 'will convict the world concerning sin, and right-: eousness and judgment' (Jn. 16: 8). This means, it is the Holy Spirit who impresses upon a sinner's heart the offence of unbelief, the deviation of not living right, and the horrors of judgment. The primary tool by which this conviction takes place, is the Word of God - 'the sword of the spirit'. Consider the imagery 'conviction ... by sword', and feel the weight of the matter. No amount of good advice and skill for making altar-calls can get a sinner to turn from sin and believe in Jesus. Conviction of sin is impossible without the Holy Spirit. Through the mix of the preaching of God's Word, and the Holy Spirit's conviction in the heart, regeneration results. 'For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, trough the living and enduring Word of God. (1 Pet 1: 23).
- 4. As part of our salvation, the Holy Spirit makes us members of God's family with untold benefits. The Holy Spirit indwells us as evidence that we belong to God's family (Rom 8:9b) and comforts us (Jn. 14: 16,17). He helps us to know we are children of God (Rom 8:14 – 17), and rejoice even in suffering and hope for the glory of God (Rom 5: 5).
- 5. The Holy Spirit sanctifies and makes us more Christ like. The Holy Spirit indwells us to make us holy, and this is important because 'without holiness, no man shall see the Lord'. (Heb. 12:14). As without the Spirit's birth the naked sinner cannot turn to God for dress, so without the Spirit's • help, the saint cannot be ready for heaven. The Holy Spirit equips us with the power to live holy lives and grow in godliness. (2 Pet 1:3-4). He produces fruit in the lives of believers as evidence of his indwelling them. [Gal:
- 6. The Holy Spirit seals our salvation. The Holy Spirit ensures that those He has regenerated will make it to heaven. His indwelling the Christian serves as a seal of salvation: He is God's own down payment for the salvation transaction.

As Christians, we should be thankful to the Holy Spirit for His role in our salvation, and worship Him. Let us preach the gospel to all, trusting that HE will apply the words we speak to sinners' hearts and save them. For our country and the world, we need to regularly pray that missions and evangelism efforts will benefit from the Holy Spirit's ministry to send the gospel to many sinful hearts. May we see an outpouring of the Holy Spirit's work in our church and country.
