Sermon Summary for 17th February, 2019

"THE HOLY SPIRIT PRODUCES LOVE"

1 John 4: 7 - 12: Galatians 5: 22 - 26 Dr. Frederick L. Phillips

The apostle John challenges believers to love one another with the same kind of love that God showed to us through Christ Jesus (1 John 4:7 – 12). God's love for us - while we were still sinners, and alienated from him - cost him the : life of his only begotten Son! When we believe that Jesus Christ is the one who saves us from our sins, and accept the offer of salvation God extends to us in Christ, we are given the ability to become children of God who are "born : of God" (John 1:11-13). This supernatural birth places in us, the very nature of God so we can love as God does. "God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit whom he has given us" (Rom 5:5b). This kind of loving does not spring from feelings, but is a sacrificial act on the part of the one who loves, for the benefit of the one loved, whether it is reciprocated or not. (John 3:16; 1 John 3:16; Rom. 5:8; John 15:13). It needs God's input if it is to be exhibited. And so John can say: "Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God."

Jesus Christ declared: "Love one another just as I have loved you. By this: (not by powerful miracles!) all men will know you are my disciples." (John: 13:35). Similarly, Paul begins his exposition of love with the warning that miraculous gifts and wonders are worthless in themselves without love (1 Corinth. 13:1-3). Gifts are not being pitted against love here – both are required, but the former must be undergirded with love to be effective. Note that the facets of love that Paul goes on to enumerate have positives - what love is - and negatives - what love is not. If we do not learn to balance these two aspects, we stand in danger of going astray. God's love is not soft! It disciplines, where necessary

Let us learn to respect fellow believers who disagree with us on an issue, and not immediately consider them candidates for deliverance! They may have prayed as long, if not longer, than we have. "Love is not proud; it does not : insist on its own way". We are all human, and we can, and we do make mistakes! Let us be teachable.

Regarding new converts who have been ostracized by their families, and who : Feb 26: Ms. Awushie Dovlo could even be in danger of being killed to remove the "disgrace" from the family: sometimes those offering shelter to such converts may themselves become targets of physical and spiritual attack. Are we prepared to lay down our lives for such? 1 John 3:16 says explicitly that we should!

What about our spouses? Are you doing for your partner, what you would want them to do for you? 1 John 4:20 says: "anyone who does not love his brother whom he has seen. cannot love God whom he has not seen."

So then, let us love not in words, but indeed, for God is love, and anyone who does not love in His sacrificial way, does not know God
