Sermon Summary for 3rd March, 2019

"THE HOLY SPIRIT PRODUCES PATIENCE, KINDNESS AND GOODNESS" Galatians 5: 15 - 26; Colossians 3: 12 - 17 Dr. Yaw Perbi

Whether it is the 1994 Rwandan genocide or Kenya's 2008 post-election tribal conflict at a time when these countries were 90% and 80% 'Christian': respectively, the patience, kindness and goodness of 'Christians' has often been called into question. The fact that Africa has the most Christians in the world now (631 million) should show qualitatively in the exhibition of the fruit of the Holy Spirit in our lives by:

1. CENTERING ON THE CHIEF CULTIVATOR ABOVE US

Our emphasis should not so much be on the fruit but the ultimate reason, source and focus of a fruitful Christian life: the Holy Spirit who produces them. This is neither a human idea nor endeavour! It is only HE who is able to supernaturally produce radical goodness, kindness and patience in us: because that is who he is—patient (Numbers 14:17-18, 2 Peter 3:8-9), kind (Ps. 36:7, Ps. 145:9, Isaiah 63:7, Ephesians 2:6-7, Titus 3:4-6. Exodus 33:19) and **good** (Ps. 34:8, Ps. 100:5, Ps. 107:1, James 1:17)! Both ministry abilities (charismata) and fruit (character) are GIFTS of the Spirit. Bearing these fruit is essential to the nature and mission of God on earth as his image bearers, "ALL THIS IS FROM GOD..."

2. CURBING THE CULTURAL WEEDS AROUND US

All three fruit are closely related. "Kindness is goodness in action" (Strong's). The word kindness also "describes the ability to act for the welfare of those taxing your patience." It's all one fruit: love. There are things from our culture/world that impede our formation of patience, kindness, goodness. We have a huge challenge cultivating goodness in the midst of a self-help culture, kindness is impeded by the big weed of autonomy/self-sufficiency while patience/longsuffering is under threat from the cultures of productivity and instant gratification yet Christian discipleship is a slow and deep work of the Holy Spirit!

3. CULTIVATING THE SPIRIT'S FRUIT WITHIN US

Although fruit-bearing is a human-divine partnership, we overestimate what we can do for ourselves and underestimate what God can do in us! These three practices of silence, Sabbath and community will help you "be led, be dead" (Gal. 5:16, 18, 24, 25) and to "set and let" (Col. 3:1-2, 15-16) so that : Mar 13: Nii Kwanchie Ankrah the Holy Spirit of God produces patience, kindness and goodness in you!
