Sermon Summary for 24th February, 2019

"THE HOLY SPIRIT PRODUCES JOY AND PEACE"

Galatians 5: 22 - 26: 1 Thessalonians 1: 4 - 10 Mr. Daniel Agamah

God wants you to experience happy times (as long as God approves of what: is happening) but His greater desire is that you have unconditional joy. Jesus said His joy would "remain in you" (John 15:11) and "your joy no one : will take from you" (John 16:22). The long-range evidence of joy is gratitude, contentment, optimism and a sense of freedom. This is what God wants for us. God does not want us to gratify the desires of the flesh. God wants us to experience His presence. His Peace. His Joy.

The "fruit of the Spirit" is not the result of any effort anyone can make. It is not the effort to have faith or to obey or to be loving and kind or to try to be iovful. What Paul has in mind here is what comes out of a person who has been filled with the Holy Spirit.

When we follow Jesus and believe in the power of what He did on the cross for us, God fills us with the Holy Spirit. Therefore, the fruit of the Spirit is the natural result of the presence of the Holy Spirit residing in a believer and changing their character so that they manifest good "fruit."

If we look for God's work and gifts in our lives, we will always have joy. On the other hand, if we get caught up in temporary hardships and worldly desires, our joy will be fleeting and weak. Even in hardship, our joy must remain, because it depends on God and His promises. So, Christian joy is: not the absence of trials but the presence of Christ in our lives!

The Biblical definition of Peace is taken from the common Jewish greeting, "Shalom." which means completion and fulfilment. It connotes health, completeness and safety. This peace that comes from the Holy Spirit does not mean lack of conflict but it is the inner calm that results from confidence in one's saving relationship with Christ.

When we permit the leadership of the Holy Spirit in our life, we will enter the most remarkable and unforgettable season of calm and inner peace we could imagine. Man cannot give this peace. Popularity does not create this kind of peace. Wealth cannot produce this peace. Psychiatrists cannot produce this kind of peace.

So don't give way to the flesh and allow it to produce its ugly work in your life. Instead, yield to the Spirit and allow the seed of God's Spirit and Word to produce the fruit of the Spirit in your life. You are the one who makes the ultimate decision of who is going to rule you, so choose wisely today.
