Sermon Summary for 7th April, 2019

"THE SPIRIT IS OUR LIFELINE"

John 14: 15 - 24: Ephesians 3: 7 - 21

The nature and role of the Spirit in our lives is central to our identity. In John 14:15-23, Jesus teaches about the Holy Spirit. v15 is not about: salvation by works. Obedience is a response to love which is a response to our belief. God's response is to give us the Holy Spirit who will be with us forever. The commands of Jesus in John are "Receive" : "Follow" "Get up" "Rise Up" "Believe" "Abide" Ask" "Love" "Receive". It: makes sense that Jesus would then say, 'If you love me then you will: receive me, and believe me, and abide in me and love others.

The disciples would grieve for Jesus but he gave them the promise of a much fuller life. Jesus tells them that He is in the father, we are in him and he in us. This incredible truth is difficult to comprehend but has huge implications for us. God present in us and ONLY available to: those that believe and love him.

In Eph 3, Paul, clearly understands what Jesus was sharing in John 14, that the Holy Spirit will teach us all things, v10 tells us that God has: chosen to reveal himself to the spirit realm through the community of God's people. This is our responsibility, our privilege!

Paul then prays that believers would be strengthened with power through the Holy Spirit in their inner being. Remember from John 14 that Jesus is in the father, we are in Jesus and Jesus is in us and that: Jesus and the Father desire to make their home with us. What an amazing privilege and responsibility we have to understand the love of God present in us so that we may be filled with all the fullness of God!

'According to the power at work within us' shows that it is our responsibility to have a posture of love an obedience to allow him to work. We have been enveloped by the Triune God, who desires to work through : Apr 15: Mrs. Emma Petterson

The Spirit is our lifeline and so much more than that. He has given us :: Apr 16: Ms. Abena A. Kissi-Twum potential "more abundantly than all that we ask or think".


