# Sermon Summary for 14th April, 2019

#### "EMPOWERED TO SERVE"

Mr. Nana Fosu Nyante Ps 118: 26-27; Zech 9: 9-10; Matt 21: 1-11; Matt 21: 12-17

To empower means to give (someone) the authority or power to do something. Other synonyms include authorize, permit, allow, warrant, commission, certify, qualify; invest, endow.

To serve also means to help, to aid, to assist, attend, oblige, work, work for and to **function** – The proof that a product/item/machine works is when it functions.

When a computer works/functions, them it is fulfilling its intended purpose, i.e. the purpose for which it was built.

### Young People in God's Plan

Right from the Old Testament through the New Testament God has had a special place for young people. We see God protecting, nurturing, loving, strengthening, empowering, and using them in mighty ways.

- God protected baby Moses & provided a place for him to be nurtured.
- Joshua and Caleb had godly courage.
- Brave young David defeated Goliath the giant when everyone was afraid.
- Young Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego refused to bow.
- A little girl showed mighty Naaman where to go for his healing.
- A little boy gave 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish to Jesus to feed the 5000.

It's clear throughout Scripture that young people have a place in God's grand plan. He loves them; He put a special gift in them and wants them to be of use for His praise and glory.

How then can we all be Empowered for His service?

- : 1. We need to have a revelation (see and know) Christ Jesus. The young people called him Lord and Saviour because Christ had been revealed to them and they knew. Even the teachers of the law didn't catch this, rather they were upset (Mt 21:15 & 16). From the lips of children, God has ordained praise...Ps 8:2. God has given grace in this season for children to see, to hear, to know. Yes to know the deep things, the revealed Word, to know God as Father, Lord and Saviour! Parents, guardian, and the Church must make room and provide opportunities for them. Mt 19:14, are we hindering or helping young people to come to Christ and have a relationship? They're neither a nuisance nor an inconvenience. Don't keep them away from Service, Prayer Meetings, Sunday School where they can encounter Jesus. Lead them to Christ.
- 2. Grow, Nurture, Activate the gifts. We must commit to studying, meditating, applying the Word. Also give yourselves to prayer, fellowship, witnessing. Let's stir up the gifts in us 2 Tim 1:6. There is no shorter route... Activate the gifting by doing. Let's be intentional, deliberate, consistent and guided by the Holy Spirit.
- 3. Serve and be of use to the Lord. Let's use what we have; our talents, gifts, profession, knowledge, money to function. Let it count in Heaven. The Children shouted, they made voices, even when the Scribes were upset. But Jesus allowed them, Mt 21:16, and they shouted the more. Let's continue in good work, do not faint purity, holiness. Jn 15:16, Rom 12:1, 1 Cor 15:58, 1 Tim 4:12, : Gal 6:9. 1 Tim 4:15

A church that intentionally emphasizes & invests in its Children's Ministry and young people will ultimately by the grace of God have empowered young people becoming responsible adults. And if we are intentional, deliberate, consistent and guided by the Holy Spirit, then these same young ones you see today, will take up leadership in the Church, and will be positive influences in our society & generation for God's glory.
