#### "USE THE GIFT YOU HAVE RECEIVED" 1 Corinthians 6: 19 - 20: 1 Peter 4: 7 - 11 Mr.

In line with the focus of our AGM to review our stewardship of God's resources, we are urged to use the gifts God has given us. Based on 1 Peter 4: 10 – 11 here are four key lessons we can learn.

#### 1. Who are the gifted ones? Every Christian has a gift from God.

Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. (I Cor 12:7). A gift is any endowment or capacity given freely by God to his people. Some of the gifts are listed in Rom 12: 6-8, 1 Cor 12:8 -11, and Eph. 4:11. They range from eye-popping miracles to simply hosting guests. We don't acquire these gifts by human effort; they are qiven by God. We however need to exercise them regularly so we don't : lose their effectiveness. Each Christian is gifted uniquely, because the gift comes with a measure of grace (Eph. 4:7) and a measure of faith (Rom 12:3). These factors, together with our individual personalities and upbringing, make each of us unique in our gifting. It is therefore unnecessary to be envious of someone's gifting. You may lack merit but not value. Don't look down on your gift. Don't be afraid to be you. Only you can : exercise your gift the way you can. No gift is more, or less important than the other. Use the gift God has given you. Start from home - serve your family. Serve your nation and church. As much as possible, link your service to your diffing. Let us give all Christians the opportunity to serve. The popular imagery of the church is that of the human body. When one person does not serve for whatever reason, the entire body suffers. A person may lack merit, but certainly not value.

 What are the gifts to be used for? <u>The gifts should be used to serve</u> others.

3. How are the gifts to be used? When we serve by speaking, we should do so as ones speaking the very words of God. In all service, we should depend on the strength God provides.

**4.** What is the purpose of the gifts? <u>They are for God's praise and his glory</u>. In serving God and His people, there are moments of discouragement, criticisms and accusations. But a focused commitment to bring praise to God through our service will often guide our efforts properly.


